Born in Nagygyed, Transsilvania 20.06.1931.

1950-1955 University Loránd Eötvös, Chemistry. Budapest

1955-2000 I worked at the University Loránd Eötvös and The Hungarian Academy of Sciences teaching and making researches in the field of chemistry. I had also spent shorter-longer periods of time at different universities in Germany, Italy and Canada. 1962 I got my PHD title, 1995 the degree "Doctor of Hungarian Academy of Sciences".

Between 1950-1964 I attended various artschools in Budapest learning painting and drawing. In 1969, I had a solo exhibition at the Eötvös Club, Budapest, presenting paintings and graphics. 1968-1972 I participated at various anantgard collective exhibitions, and published graphics in the periodicals valóság, Kortárs and Igaz Szó. I also organized exhibitions for avantgard artists at the Eötvös Club, Budapest. I organized and for a couple of years conducted an artschool at the University Loránd Eötvös.

Since 2000 I am working as photographer.
