

Barbara Yelin, born 1977 in Munich, studied illustration at the Hamburg University of Applied Sciences. She lives in Munich, Germany, and works as an illustrator and comics artist. Her comic novels include »[Le Visiteur](#)« (2004), »[Le Retard](#)« (2006), both published by Actes Sud/L'An 2, and »[Gift](#)« (2010, with Peer Meter), published by Reprodukt. „Irmira“ (Reprodukt 2014) is her most recent graphic novel, on which she did work on for more than three years. Barbara Yelin also taught as a visiting professor at the HBKsaar (university of art and design Saarbrücken) 2012 and drew the daily comic-strip "Riekes Notizen" for the German newspaper Frankfurter Rundschau.
